

## Summer Playground Program (ages 6-13)

This program is primarily an outdoor **DROP-IN** program for children who are Redford Residents. Children must be able to be picked up within 10 minutes or be able to walk home in case of an emergency or inclement weather. Pre-registration required before participation at any site. There are sign in sheets at each park, but children are free to come and go. Each site is supervised by counselors to provide a fun, safe and structured environment. They will have daily activities, games, arts and crafts, board games and more that are centered around a weekly theme. The program runs M-F, however one day a week will be a field trip day, but please note these are separate from the program and spaces are very limited and available on a first-come first-serve basis.
